Event report:

On 31st July 2017 the drive was organized in collaboration with SCHC. The Blood Donation Drive was organized by SCHC and was carried out with a lot of enthusiastic individuals who came forward to donate blood. Like every year, S.P.A.R.S.H. actively took part in volunteering and promoting this event at SIU Lavale, Hill top campus. Over 200 people including students, faculty, security guards and other staff turned up and showed their willingness to donate blood.

For creating awareness about blood donation drive and motivating people to donate, various promotional activities are performed, such as flash mob and street on the preceding day which usually gets a great response. S.P.A.R.S.H has been well appreciated for all the work we have been doing through the support and admiration of all.

On account of Birthday of Symbiosis Founder and Chancellor Dr. S. B. Mujumdar Symbiosis Centre of Health Science had conducted a blood donation camp in the campus in association with Pune Serological blood bank on 01st August, 2016.

This camp was coordinated, operated and volunteered by SITM. Response was huge and many students from all Symbiosis University Lavale Campus voluntarily came up to donate blood. Faculties from various institutes also made came and encouraged donors. S.P.A.R.S.H also got appreciation from SCHC for promoting (Flash Mob)and smoothly coordinating the event.

- Intending donors get opportunity to donate according to their convenience.
- It requires 350 ml of blood to save someone's life.
- Some people had been donating on a regular basis; while others who were first timers, got rid
 of their apprehensions.
- To combat the demand-supply mismatch, the community needs to donate blood throughout the year. We urge all eligible donors to donate blood every three months regularly.
- The blood is usually drawn from the median cubical vein, from the inside of the elbow. The
 amount of blood along with the anti-coagulants present in the collection bag is referred to as
 one unit of blood.
