- 2016, with the fantastic theme 'Ideations Unlimited- Dare to Share'

SPEAKERS OF THE EVENT

1. Padma Shri Dr. Syed Kirmani

Legendary Indian Wicket Keeper

The event began with the talk of the iconic Wicketkeeper Padma Shri Dr. Syed Kirmani. He belongs to a generation when wicketkeeping was an art and a niche pursuit. He was awarded the Padma Shri in 1982 and the best wicket keeper in the 1983 Cricket World Cup. He talked about his experience in 1983 World Cup: Corridors of victory and asked the students to keep up a positive attitude, even in the face of adversity for the wonders it can do.



2. Dr. Latika Nath

Wildlife Conservationist, Photographer and Author

Bestowed with the title of 'The tiger Princess' by national Geographic Dr. Latika Nath is the first woman and Indian to have a doctorate on Tigers from Oxford University. She was also the ambassador for Aircel's Save the Tiger television campaign. She talked about how the journey has transformed her as well as the people around her. The struggles as a young woman in the field and her Brave ride into the wild.



3. Dr. Varkha Chulani

Clinical Psychologist, Psychotherapist & Enablement Expert

A graduate from the Mithibhai College of Arts in Psychology, a Master's Degree in Clinical Psychology from the University of Mumbai and an Associate Fellow and Supervisor of The Albert Ellis Institute, New York City, USA. She is a consultant for the Lilavati Hospital, Mumbai besides being in private practice. She is also author of 2 independently authored books, she has also co-authored 3 with her professor. She talked the importance of 'Intrinsic Happiness' and how important it is to get into engaging activities to be a happier person.



4. Subramanyeswar S

Chief Strategy Officer, Lowe Lintas

Better known as 'Subbu', he is a regular columnist and a passionate academic, he is a frequent speaker and has delivered talks at the world famous Kellogg School of Management, Illinois and MIT Sloan.
