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Best Practice 1: Title: Induction Program with Online Pre-Induction Portal and Program with Domain and life skill and Motivation orientation

- 1) Objectives of the Practice: Orientation of Students during Induction to understand value systems. Both formal about domain and informal with life skill and Motivation orientation for holistic development.
- 2) The Context: SITM has offered an (i) online pre-induction program to all students. This was accompanied by sessions from faculty members as a part of pre-induction. It helped students to overcome issues related to various courses taught in this program. (ii) SITM has also offered an induction program that consists of sessions from industry experts, entrepreneurs, alumni, etc. The most important feature is a discussion on life skills, motivation, management lessons from Bhagwat Gita which helped students to have an overall view of the management program. It also included an outbound program of one day which helped students to interact with each other and learn management lessons such as leadership, coordination, and planning.
- 3) The Practice: (i) About Pre-Induction -Telecom management has a spread of several subjects from the domains of technology, finance, and marketing fall under its overarching umbrella. 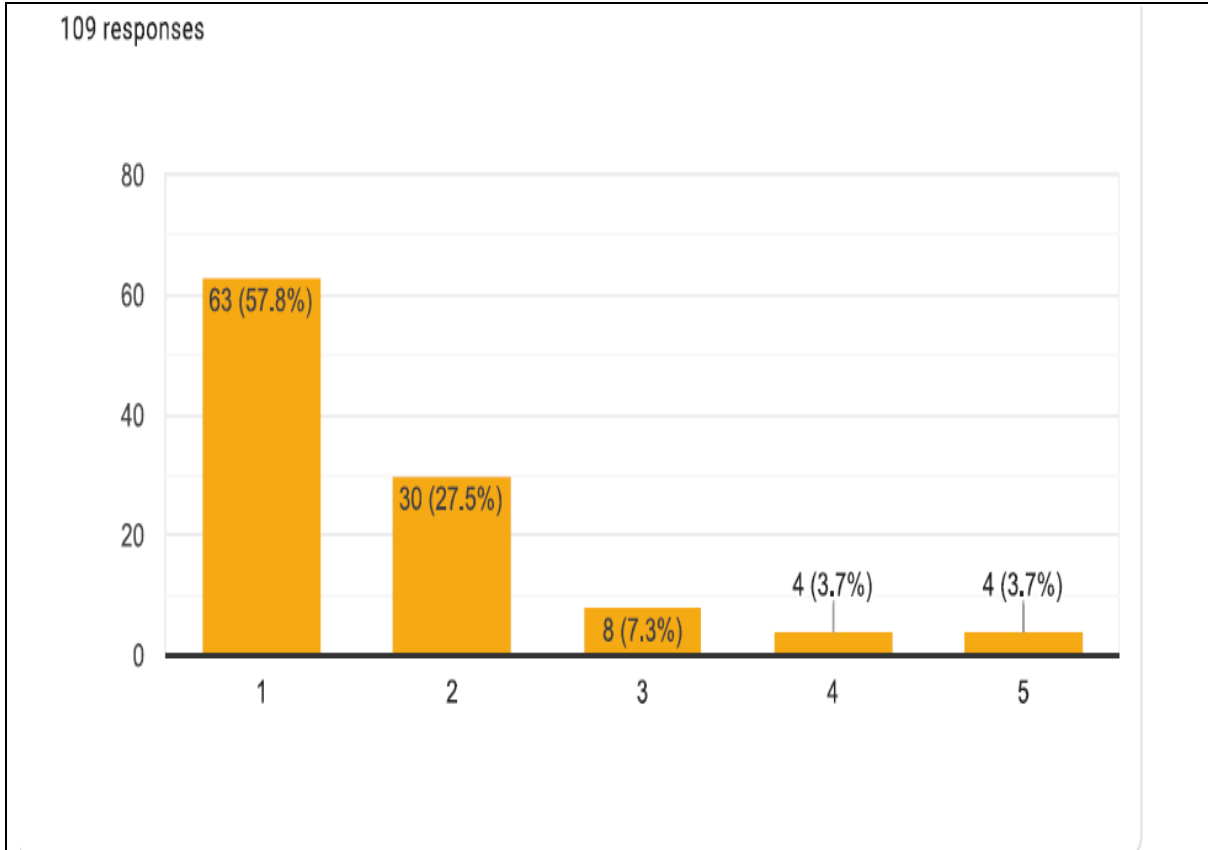


Figure 1: Induction Satisfaction Index
